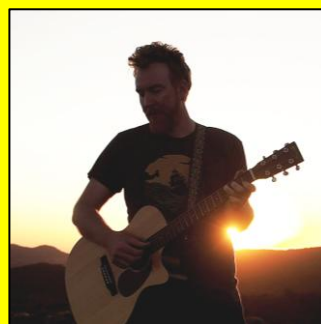
Jean Marshall and Jess Fox 1:00 – 1:30pm
